Commencement of Performance Audits

The Auditor-General is commencing two performance audits that were not identified in the Performance Audit Program 2016-17 and Potential Audits to Commence over 2017-18 to 2018-19:

- the Land Development Agency's (LDAs) assembly of rural land in the ACT; and
- ACT Government agency performance indicators.

The audit of the Land Development Agency's (LDAs) assembly of rural land in the ACT will examine:

- why the ACT Government seeks to assemble rural land
- how the LDA seeks to assemble rural land
- how the LDA has assembled rural land since 2012
- how effective the LDA has been in assembling rural land

The audit of ACT Government agency performance indicators will seek to identify whether:

- ACT Government agencies have effective processes for the selection, review and approval of strategic indicators and accountability indicators
- ACT Government agencies' strategic and accountability indicators are relevant and appropriate in measuring ACT Government agencies' performance

The Audit Office will also commence an audit on the Management of Public Art in the ACT. Thereby bringing forward a potential audit previously identified in Performance Audit Program 2016-17 and Potential Audits to Commence over 2017-18 to 2018-19.
