Auditor-General's future performance audits

ACT Auditor-General, Mr Michael Harris, today announced the **2020-21 Performance Audit Program**.

The ACT Audit Office has undertaken consultation across the ACT Public Service and with a range of community organisations to develop the **2020-21 Performance Audit Program**. The program has been developed having regard to the Audit Office's mandate and strategic plan and aims to balance coverage across the ACT government.

Mr Harris says 'the ACT Audit Office has selected performance audit topics that consider areas of risk and potential opportunities for improved accountability, governance and performance in the public-sector.'

Each performance audit topic selected for inclusion in the **2020-21 Performance Audit Program** aligns with one or more of Mr Harris's six focus areas. The six key focus areas include:

- Effectively protecting our environment;
- Making evidence-based decisions to invest wisely for the future and reduce waste;
- Delivering effective services to meet the expectations of the community;
- Embracing technology, innovation and digital disruption;
- Providing a safe and inclusive community; and
- Learning from the past to deliver improved outcomes.
