ACT Auditor-General, Mr Michael Harris, today announced the *Performance Audit Program 2019-20 and Potential Audits for 2020-21 and beyond*.

Mr Harris says 'The forward Performance Audit Program has been developed after consultation and a strategic analysis to identify the topic areas; topics selected continue to focus on high risks to the Territory'.

Performance audits to be presented to the Speaker for tabling in 2019-20 are:

- Shared Services
- Maintenance of school infrastructure

Performance audits expected to commence in 2019-20 are:

- Data security
- Chronic diseases programs and services
- Waste management
- Affordable housing
- Canberra Light Rail
- Health services for detainees
- Planning and development processes for urban renewal
- Use of closed-circuit television
- Support for Indigenous persons
- ACT Ambulance Service
- Transfer of workers compensation arrangements from ComCare
